






The 8th IFRAP Steering Committee Meeting, chaired by Federal Minister for Planning, Development & Special Initiatives, Mr. Ahsan Iqbal Chaudhary and Mr. Sarfraz Bugti Chief Minister Balochistan brought together key stakeholders to review the progress of rehabilitation projects in Balochistan's flood-affected regions

The meeting was attended by senior officials, including Minister Planning Balochistan Mir Zahoor Ahmed Buledi, Chief Secretary Balochistan Shakil Qadir Khan, Additional Chief Secretary Development Hafiz Abdul Basit, Principal Secretary to CM Balochistan Babar Khan, representatives from EAD, and PIUs of IFRAP. Project Director IFRAP Mr. Asfandiar Khan briefed participants on the project's current progress update. It was highlighted that 10,000 housing units will be constructed through owner driven initiatives during the current financial year.



A key highlight of the discussion was the Chief Minister's proposal to integrate The World Bank's rehabilitation-linked Internship program with the Chief Minister **Youth Skills Development Program Balochistan**, ensuring sustainable skill-building and employment opportunities for Balochistan's youth. Minister Ahsan Iqbal appreciated and welcomed the proposal.

04 COLLECTION OF DATA FOR APPROXIMATELY 150,000 BENEFICIARIES IN RECORD TIME

Mr. Muhammad Rafay Durrani (M&E Specialist, IFRAP) and Dr. Barira Bakhtawar (Communications Specialist, IFRAP) visited the HRU office in Quetta. The visit aimed to strengthen and enhance field-level engagement in the areas of Communications and M&E. The PPMU team engaged with the HRU and implementing partner teams to review the validation process and gain firsthand insights. During the visit to PIP Tameer e Khalaq Foundation, they assessed ongoing efforts. Another meeting was conducted with the communications focal points of all HRU PIPs to discuss strategies for enhanced outreach and visibility.

The visit involved rigorous discussions with the HRU team, focusing on identifying challenges in communications and M&E and exploring solutions to ensure smooth project implementation.



A key highlight was the impressive achievement of the HRU in ensuring Quality Assurance in the process of data collection with limited human resource and the PIP teams who successfully collection of data for approximately 150,000 beneficiaries in record time.


