🚧 Roads Infrastructure Sub-Component

🔍 Field Engagement at Shah Alam Bridge, Quetta

Component 1 team on site with M/s Zeerak International at Shah Alam Bridge as the consultants commenced their initial field survey to identify context-specific solutions under the Roads & Bridges portfolio.

🌊 Irrigation Sub-Component Mobilized

On-ground survey work is now underway for critical flood and water management interventions, including:

✓ Zaida Dami/Check Dams

✓ Flood Protection Works in District Pishin
