FPMU-IFRAP is investing in stronger PIU capacity. From 22–25 September 2025, IFRAP M&E Specialist Muhammad Rafay Durrani and team led interactive working sessions with HRU (M&E, MIS & Infrastructure), M&E consultants, and QA firms to align on progress and accelerate integration.

- **22 Sept** — Internal alignment: Agreed on an integrated M&E sampling methodology, spot-check approach, API integration for dashboards, and explored AI for data validation.
- **23 Sept** — M&E firm: Reviewed baseline progress, spot-check updates, and the revised M&E framework & indicators post-restructuring.
- **24 Sept** — QA firm: Sharpened physical progress reviews, field monitoring methods, and sample sizes to ensure accuracy and reliability.
- **25 Sept** — Wrap-up & AI integration: Shared key recommendations for implementation.

The ICT Specialist IFRAP Dr. Bakhtiar Khan Kasi, with HRU MIS teams, scoped how AI can strengthen GRM, enable construction-stage validation, optimize data pipelines, and support core MIS functions.
