A joint field visit to the Sohbatpur-Hairdin Road corridor was conducted by the IFRAP - Integrated Flood Resilience and Adaptation Project - Post Flood 2022 PIU (Component I)- Community Infrastructure Rehabilitation and the design team from Zeeruk International Pvt. Ltd. From the PIU side, Mr. Aslam zehri (Deputy Project Director) and Mr. Nadir Baloch (Assistant Engineer) led on-ground reviews with the Zeeruk team to validate design assumptions and coordinate next steps.



IFRAP Updates: Component 1 (Community Infrastructure Rehabilitation)

Quetta: On October 8, 2025, the PIU team-Component 1 (PD, DPDs, PS-Infrastructure, and the Procurement Specialist) met jointly with the Cameos Architects & Consultants, FPMU, and the World Bank Group (online) to review key observations from the Preliminary Site Assessment Report. Constructive feedback was shared, and next steps along with responsibilities were agreed for follow-up.

Strengthening Community Ownership through Village Reconstruction Committees – District Naseerabad

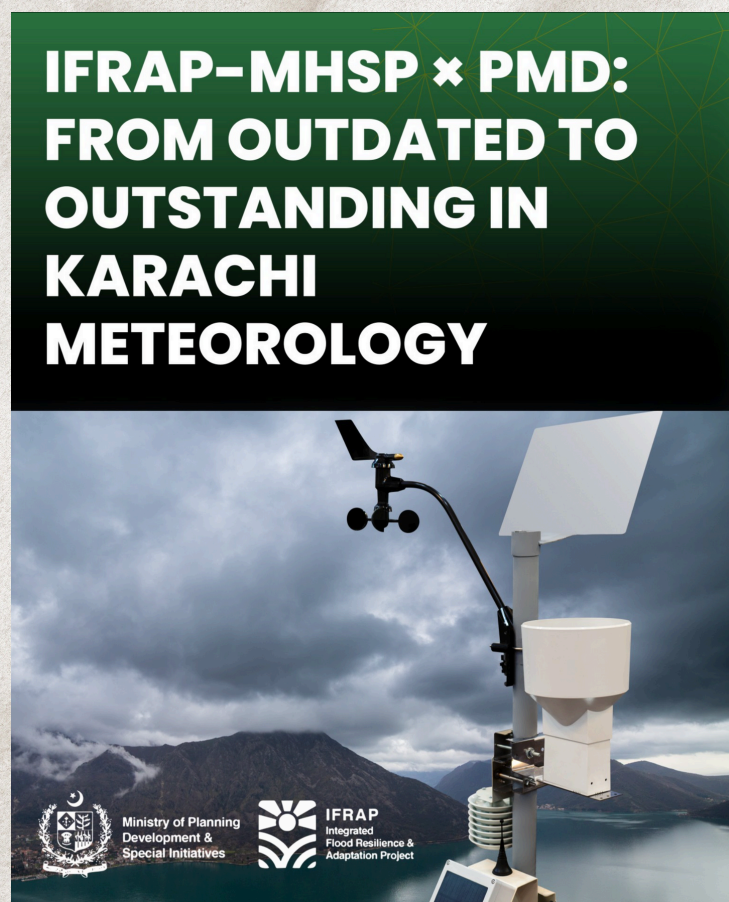
In line with the Government of Pakistan's commitment to transparent, inclusive, and community-driven housing recovery, the Regional Team of the Housing Reconstruction Unit (HRU) – IFRAP Balochistan, led by Regional Coordinator Haji Tayab Yallanzai, convened a comprehensive meeting with community representatives and Village Reconstruction Committees (VRCs) in District Naseerabad. The session was held in close coordination with the Implementation Partner, Islamic Relief Pakistan (IRP).

The meeting focused on the critical role of the VRCs in ensuring the success and sustainability of the housing reconstruction process. Discussions emphasized the thematic pillars of HRU's approach transparency, inclusion, resilience, accountability, and quality assurance.
