Progress Review Meeting on Water Sector & HRU-IFRAP Balochistan

Field Visit Update (Component-1, IFRAP)

From November 6 to 8, 2025, the Project Director (PD-PIU) and Deputy Project Director (DPD-PIU), along with the Cameos Architects & Consultants Team, Program Specialist (Infrastructure) Engr. Abdul Jalil FPMU, and the concerned XENs & SDOs, conducted field visits to key sites under Component-1 of IFRAP.

The team held detailed discussions and meetings with the Superintending Engineer, Irrigation Department, focusing on proposed interventions related to flood protection, canal rehabilitation, and infrastructure resilience.

- Restoration/Strengthening of Flood Embankment of Main Rabi Canal, District Naseerabad
- Sohbatpur Road Rehabilitation Works
- Rehabilitation of Main Drains (Rupa & Umrani Drains) in Naseerabad & Jaffarabad
- Construction of 4 Nos. VRBs at different reaches of Uch Canal, District Sohbatpur
- Flood Protection Bund for Sohbatpur Town
- Restoration/Strengthening of Flood Embankment of Hairdin Main Drain, District Sohbatpur
- Restoration/Strengthening of Flood Protection Bund near Zain-ul-Abideen Khan Khoso, Sohbatpur
- Restoration/Strengthening of Flood Protection Bund for Dera Allah Yar Town (Jaffarabad City)
